Requirements for Renting a CraigCat

1. All renters must be 18.
2. All renters must have valid drivers license and credit card.
3. All renters must agree not to consume any alcohol while operating the CraigCat or be under the influence of alcohol at the start of rental.
4. Renters are responsible for all accidents, injuries or damages incurred.
5. Renter must sign rental agreement, release of liability and any waiver forms.
6. Lake Country CraigCat, LLC reserves the right to deny rentals to persons not qualified, all CraigCats will be inspected before and after rental.
7. All operators must follow Wisconsin water laws, which will be provided prior to rental.

Prices and Terms subject to change without notice.

CraigCat Policies:

A **\$100.00 security deposit is required** for all reservations. **Cancellations must be made 7 days prior** to the rental period to receive a deposit refund less a \$25.00 processing fee. Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the rental period will forfeit the entire deposit. Also a RENTAL RESERVATION form must be filled out and faxed, emailed or mailed to us in order to secure your reservation.

CraigCat rentals require a \$400.00 credit card damage deposit.

Lake Country CraigCat, LLC is not responsible for weather. If your rental period is rained out prior to your departure you will be able to reschedule a different rental period in the future depending on availability. There will be no refunds given due to weather conditions. The renter is responsible for all damages and losses. See RENTAL AGREEMENT for more details.

Fuel and tax are not included in rental rates. The watercraft comes full of fuel. The renter will be charged for the fuel that is used.

Rental Process:

- Call Lake Country CraigCat @ 262-367-6217 to check on availability of rentals.
- Fax or mail back reservation form.
- Receive conformation of reservation.
- The day prior to rental call Lake Country CraigCat to re-confirm.
- Meet at designated launch 15 minutes prior to rental with proper identification and credit card.
- Fill out and sign all necessary paperwork.
- Receive orientation on proper use of watercraft.
- Meet Lake Country CraigCat at designated launch for pick up.

Required Forms:

- Rental Security Deposit Credit Card Authorization Form
- Watercraft Rental Agreement and Release Form

Safe Riding Practices:

- Any person operating a CraigCat must be 18 or older. Everyone who rides the CraigCat must wear a personal floatation device (PFD) at all times.
- A CraigCat should only be operated in 3 or more feet of water. Damage to the unit will occur if water is less than 3 feet deep.
- Become familiar with the area in which you will be operating.
- Be aware of hazards and speed limits.
- Become familiar with basic rules of the water particularly as they apply to vessels in sight of one another in crossing, meeting and overtaking situations.
- Travel at a slow no-wake speed for the first 200' from shore and when the situation warrants it.
- Keep a safe distance from other boaters, watercraft, swimmers, docks and keep clear of wildlife.
- Be aware that it is against the law to operate a CraigCat under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Be considerate of others by not operating for long periods in one spot or by avoiding shoreline places such as launching ramps, picnic areas and swimming areas.
- Always check the weather forecast before starting out; be alert for wave, wind and cloud changes that signal bad weather approaching.
- Carry out a pre-ride inspection as recommended by manufacture.

Driving Tips

- Know that the lanyard connection to the start/stop switch must be secured to the wrist.
- Know how to safely approach and depart from dock, always drawing near another object from the side, not head-on.
- Know how to use a chart, map and compass (if applicable).
